The 2013 Ingenuity is a poster child for our beloved GSM + Petite Sirah blend. As usual, neither too feminine nor too masculine in nature, Ingenuity does not play by the wine rule book. So much juicy red Grenache fruit explodes on the front to mid palate, with Syrah giving palatial depth and velvety tannins. Petite Sirah accentuates the texture, and Mourvèdre binds the whole package together and grounds the wine in subtle earthy tones. Exuberantly Paso yet sublimely restrained. Total yum!

2013 INGENUITY

Concentrated blueberry, sea air, lavender, sun-drenched oak leaves, cola, white pepper, vanilla - this wine screams Paso and shows great complexity. The texture and flavors linger. Exuberance and restraint!

Enters mouth with mouth watering juiciness

Fruit is fleshy and full on front; mid palate as wine waves up; down/all around the mouth

Tannins interrupt fleshiness on back palate with spicy texture which folds back to front
