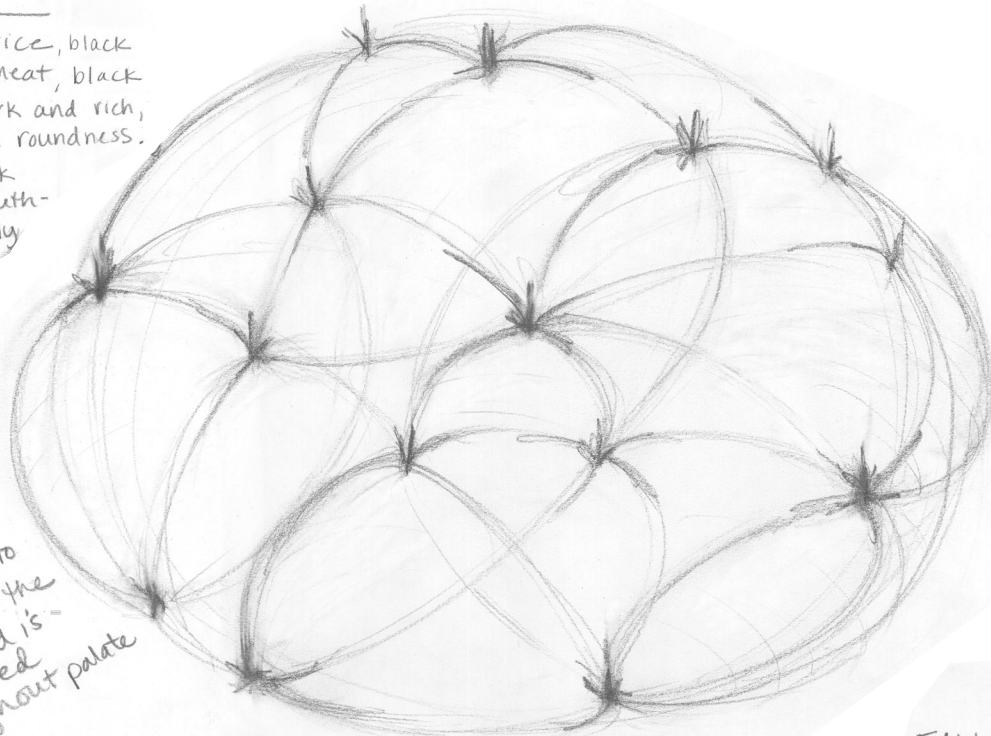
MY BIO BY WINEMAKER JORDAN FIORENTINI

He shows no hard edges, yet is loaded with texture - density, viscosity, yes, and then some. Block B is a drink for the twilight hours and later into the eve.

2013 BLOCK B

Thick, juicy black licorice, black berry extract, cured meat, black olives, this wine is dark and rich, yet there is so much roundness. Mouthfeel is pure dark chocolate, with a mouth-coating viscosity—truly unique!

Texture is integrated into roundness of the wine and is so balanced throughout palate
