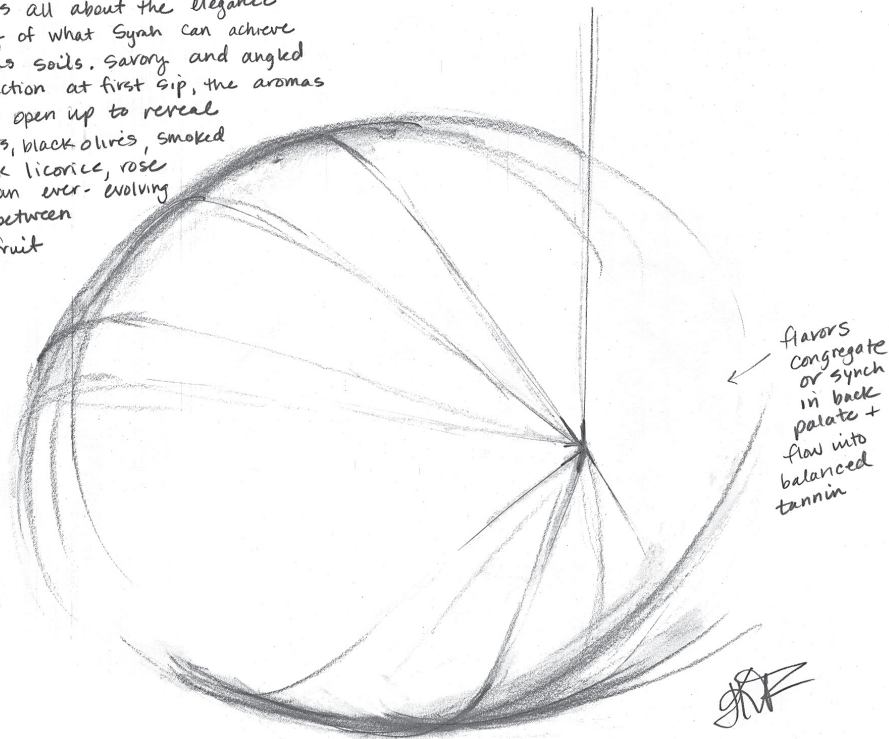
### MY BIO BY WINEMAKER JORDAN FIORENTINI

2015 Block B begs for patience in the cellar. A willingness to decant or enjoy over three days will pay off in this intricate, serious and less muscly expression of our single block Syrah bottling. Elegance abounds revealing alternating high and base notes: violets, huckleberries, dried herbs and vanillin oscillate with meaty, earthy, black olive and black licorice flavors. Polished tannins, balanced acidity and minerals captivate with every sip.



## 2015 BLOCK B

This Syrah is all about the elegance and subtlety of what Syrah can achieve on calcareous soils. Savory and angled towards reduction at first sip, the aromas and palate open up to reveal white flowers, black olives, smoked meats, black licorice, rose petals in an ever-evolving yin/yang between savory + fruit
