2019 Rosé

62% Mourvèdre | 21% Grenache | 17% Syrah

Paderewski Vineyard, Catapult Vineyard and York Mountain Vineyard

Aged four months sur lie in stainless steel barrels | 1,240 cases

With delicate notes of strawberry, hay, honeysuckle, crisp peach, and sweet lemon/lime, Mourvèdre makes a huge impression at 62% of this irresistible MGS Rhône Rosé blend. As the aromas continue to evolve as the wine warms in your glass, this rosé soars across the palate in a yin/yang balance between fruit, flowers, wet stones, saline and zingy acid. This is a wine that we crave all day long.



2018 White

47% Grenache Blanc | 42% Viognier | 11% Roussanne

Paderewski Vineyard, Catapult Vineyard and York Mountain Vineyard

Aged four months sur lie in 53% concrete and 47% in French oak barrels (14% new) | 720 cases

Refreshingly bright and exuberant, Epoch's 2018 White is bursting with gorgeous aromas, texture and minerality. Ripe green and yellow melon, wet rock, white pineapple and baking spices on the nose make your mouth water, begging for a taste. Yellow peaches, fresh cream and meyer lemon are laced through with crushed rock and delicate texture. Drink it now but also lay it down for one to four years. You won't regret it.



2015 Veracity

47% Grenache | 34% Mourvèdre | 19% Syrah

Paderewski Vineyard and Catapult Vineyard

Aged 18 months in 28% concrete tulip and 72% in French oak barrels and puncheons (24% new) | 866 cases

Grenache and Mourvèdre are playing seamlessly together (with Syrah adding a bit of moral support) as they sing out in balanced chorus in this southern-Rhône inspired beauty. Sense the balance between concrete and barrel aging in the wine's rock-licking minerality, gorgeous fresh berry and citrus fruits and fine tannin.

53% Syrah | 26% Mourvèdre | 13% Grenache | 5% Tempranillo | 3% Zinfandel

Aged 19 months in French oak barrels and puncheons (48% new) | 1,345 cases

The savory, the floral and the fruity all unite in our five-varietal Estate Blend that speaks to all of Epoch's wine practices. This focused and seamless expression of our terroir shoots across the palate with notes of raw and smoked meats, black olives, roasted herbs, cherry, cassis, anise, lavender and vanilla dust.

2015 Ingenuity

51% Syrah | 28% Mourvèdre | 14% Petite Sirah | 7% Grenache

Paderewski Vineyard and Catapult Vineyard

Aged 19 months in French oak barrels and puncheons (60% new) | 1,128 cases

The 2015 Ingenuity presents all its characteristic black and blue fruits, spice and licorice, however, it does so in a more reserved fashion than most vintages. This California Rhône blend continues to reveal fresh aromatics after being open for 24-plus-hours, and the tannins move from picante to velvety as oxygen softens their structure. Enjoy the bramble berry, roasted herbs, smoke meats, graphite, wet rock and sweet tobacco notes that ride high on the palate, continuously evolving.

2015 Tempranillo

99% Tempranillo | 1% Grenache

Paderewski Vineyard and Catapult Vineyard

Aged 19 months in French oak barrels (60% new) | 390 cases

Cellar this fresh and structured serious bottling. The tannins need time to broaden, and the aromas and flavors need exposure to air to open and reveal dried bing cherry, red plum, pipe tobacco, dried tea leaves, pencil lead and a savory gaminess. A vanilla, toasty barrel spice is subtle but frames and adds layers to the palate. Fans of Tempranillo, a gift is in store for you.
