WINEMAKING

We strive to craft wines that are both elegant and bold, wines that are testaments to our special estate vineyards on which they are grown. To achieve this more direct representation of terroir in our wines, we start with organic and biodynamic farming practices tailored to each of our three vineyards sites. Our winemaking practices echo our vineyard practices with the ultimate goal of having our dedication to quality and admiration for our land reflected in each glass of Epoch wine.

PADEREWSKI VINEYARD

Home to intense earth that bears little resemblance to typical California soils, our Paderewski Vineyard is filled with lean, rocky, and calcareous soil profiles. Located in Paso's Willow Creek District, this vineyard reaps the rewards of residing in the region with the largest diurnal temperature swing in California. Daily, temperatures can vary here as much as 50 degrees, creating the ideal environment for achieving that perfect acidity in ripening wine grapes.

CATAPULT VINEYARD

Our Catapult Vineyard is also located in the Willow Creek District of Paso Robles and sits directly in the heart of the famous Templeton Gap breezeway. This property's extreme, rocky soils are packed with silicious shale and little limestone content, the type of soil that encourages its vines to struggle while finding nourishment deep within the ground. The reward of this hardworking vine are berries packed with complexity and intense flavors.

YORK MOUNTAIN VINEYARD

Located just seven miles from the Pacific Ocean at an elevation of 1,500 feet, our historic York Mountain Vineyard falls in the small 640 acre York Mountain AVA, which is just outside of the much larger Paso Robles AVA. The soils and climate here are very different from our other two vineyards: sand and sandstone soils (some areas look like you are on the beach) along with a very moderate climate due to the even closer proximity to the ocean.



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
