Both candied and fresh violets jump out of the glass, complexed by grilled herbs, sweet leather and black cherry. So good right now it will be hard to wait, but just imagine what she will become!

2013 AUTHENTICITY

Fresh + candied violets, crushed rock, dried thyme, sweet worn leather, fresh red raspberry. — the aromas are ever-evolving! More earth on palate with black + green olive, black licorice, tart cherry, and a memorable chalky tannin finale.
