
Bringing the proverbial iron fist, velvet glove that we seek in our wines, 2014 Block B is big but refined. Chock full of chalky tannins, blackberry, huckleberry and black currant fruit, rock-licking minerality and Paderewski's signature earthy brine / white flower combo, this wine is Syrah from head to toe, entry to finish, first sniff to hours of decant. Watch this youngster age, and you will be wowed by the gifts of patience.



2014 BLOCK B

Text book Paderewski and undoubtedly Syrah. Texture and flavors pop in 3D all over the palate - Roasted meat, bay leaf, brine, white flowers, black fruits. Structure is big but balanced from front to back of palate.
