
Pure bliss, the 2017 Authenticity softly folds across the palate like a velvet curtain dropping in slow motion. Texture builds with subsequent sips, adding sophistication and seriousness. Luxurious red plum and raspberry mix with roasted red meat, sweet leather, wild herb resin, vanilla, black tea, and brown spices. As always, the Syrah component comes from one hillside at Paderewski (Block 4A) and is combined with a dollop of Mourvèdre for its grounding, earthy attributes. This 2017 sees a sprinkling of Viognier as well, offering notes of ginger and white flowers.



2017 AUTHENTICITY

Velvety layers of sweet red fruits, vanilla, roasted meats + herbs, and dried tobacco leaves fill front palate and carry thru to finish. Texture sets in slowly adding structure to the back palate and folding forward. Decadent yet grounded with refreshing acid, minerality and ripe tannin.
