



Biography:	Showing the long, cooler climate gifts of vintage 2019, Epoch's Block B is brimming with savory, earthy, and spicy qualities from first pour, which open up with exposure to air in the glass and evolve into dark purple fruit, white flowers, black olives, and roasted meats. The wine shows velvety, flowing layers of fruit and earth on entry then extends out towards the finish with a growing tannin backbone. Although it's delightful now, more will be revealed after some cellar aging. <i>- Jordan Fiorentini, Winemaker</i>
